

OPERATION CHRISTMAS CHILD

A small shoebox can have a big impact. What goes into the box is fun, but what comes out of it is eternal. Be a part of changing children's lives all over the world in Jesus' Name through the power of a simple gift with Operation Christmas Child.

How to Pack a Shoebox

- Shoebox: Use an empty cardboard or plastic shoebox (average size). You can wrap the box, lid separately, but wrapping is not required.
- Boy or Girl: Decide whether your gift will be for a boy or a girl, and the age category: 2-4, 5-9, or 10-14. Use the appropriate <u>boy/girl label</u> and tape it to the top of the box.
- Fill With Gifts: Fill the box with a variety of gifts that will bring delight to a child. Include \$7 Donation Per Box to help cover shipping and other costs.

You can give online to discover the destination of your box. Or, you can write a check to Samaritan's Purse (note "OCC" on the memo line) and place it in an envelope on top of the items inside your shoebox.

- Remember to Pray for the children who will receive your shoebox gifts.
- Place a rubber band around each closed shoebox and bring it to GBF. Deadline is in November. More details coming.



Gift Suggestions

- **Toys:** Include items that children will embrace such as dolls, toy cars, stuffed animals, kazoos, harmonicas, yo-yos, jump ropes, toys that light up and make noise (with extra batteries).
- School Supplies and Coloring books
- Non-Liquid Hygiene Items: toothbrushes, bar soap, combs. washcloths. etc.
- Accessories: t-shirts, socks, hats, sunglasses, hair clips, jewelry, watches, flashlights (with extra batteries).
- A Personal Note: You may enclose a note to the child and a photo of yourself or your family. .
- **Do Not Include:** Used or damaged items; war-related items such as toy guns, knives or military figures; chocolate or food; out-of-date candy; liquids or lotions; medications or vitamins; breakable items such as snow globes or glass containers; aerosol cans.

God wants to do something unique with our lives. We are created in His image, and because of His work in us through Jesus, we have an amazing capacity to use our creativity to do more good things.
