Life is not meant to be lived alone. Jesus knew this. He loved the crowds, fed them, healed them, spoke truth to them. But Jesus also had a small group of only 12 men who he shared life with on a day to day basis. In a large church setting, it's difficult to know and be known in a deeply personal way. Lifeline groups are designed to help this.

A Lifeline group is a small group of people, meeting in a home on a regular basis, for the purpose of authentic community and spiritual growth.

Practically speaking, there's something very unique, warm, and disarming about meeting in someone's home. We want to move people out of rows and into circles. In the relaxed setting of a home, we are more likely to laugh, more likely to share, and more likely to shed a tear with someone. Plus, when we share the name of Jesus in a home, we take a step toward expanding Christ into all of life. As Christians, we have a weird tendency to categorize our life separately into Sunday morning at church, our life at home, and our life at work/school. Lifeline groups work to break that bad habit and begin to see Christ for who he is...our life (Col 3:4).

Summer is winding down and our schedules will become more routine. Groups are forming and will begin in September so please make connecting with a Lifeline group a priority for the fall. 


