She never imagined she would be a pastor's wife. As a little girl, Casey played "getting married" and assumed she would live a simple life with her husband, they would have "regular jobs" and share life together.

But God had a bigger plan. Casey met Roy when she was a freshman in high school in Howe and he was a senior. They have been together 20 years this month and celebrated 16 years of marriage on June 20. Get to know more about Casey and her role as a mom and Roy's wife on pages 2 and 3.



Meet Casey: wife, mother, mentor and child of God

Casey Vineyard Layman was awakened to the gospel in the Fall of 2000, after she and Roy experienced drastic changes in their lives that previous Spring. "The Lord had begun to open my eyes to see that I could not make it through life without knowing and following Him. It took me coming face to face with some of the sin in my life and being disgusted with it and desiring something more for my life," Casey said.

Roy and Casey were married as soon as she graduated from high school and are exactly 3 years apart, sharing the same birthday on September 6. She will be 35.

What is the most memorable event of your early married life?

Probably those first years as parents of Quinten and Trinity. We had the two of them by the time I was 21. We were kids raising kids.

Another memory was a 'We Rent Pigs' sign that Roy insisted we put on our wedding registry. It was a reference to a movie, *Lonesome Dove* that he liked. He hung it up in plain view at every little house we moved to the first few years we were married.

There is no role of "pastor's wife" in the bible, but it is a very important and difficult position that requires grace, wisdom, selflessness and patience. What's the one thing you wish you had known before Roy took his first call?



Roy began as a full-time youth pastor at FBC Howe in 2005. I wish I'd known how God was going to sovereignly equip me for what was ahead. It would have saved me a lot of unnecessary anxiety. When Roy took a job as Youth Pastor, I had never worked with youth before. I taught children's Sunday School at our church. But as a Youth Pastor's wife, all of these teenage girls just started coming to me! It freaked me out! But God knew what He was doing. And now, to this day, I couldn't imagine NOT working with students.

Strength and dignity are her clothing, and she laughs at the time to come. She opens her mouth with wisdom, and the teaching of kindness is on her tongue. She looks well to the ways of her household and does not eat the bread of idleness.

Her children rise up and call her blessed; her husband also, and he praises her..."

Proverbs 31: 25-28

What do you consider your most important responsibility as a pastor's wife?

I think my most important role is the same as of every woman in the Bible. My first responsibility is to glorify God in serving my family, my household, and my husband. *Continued on page 3*.

From Roy: "Proverbs 18:22 says, he who finds a wife finds a good thing and obtains favor from the Lord.' Casey is a reminder of the extravagant grace of God in my life. People often say that I "married up" based on Casey's good looks, and she is a stunner, no doubt. But she's so much more. She's Godly, compassionate, loyal, wise and very discerning...and FUNNY. We LAUGH so much together. Recently, I was acting like a fool in Chic-fil-A with our family and Casey laughed so hard that sweet tea came out her nose. I looked, and thought, "Wow, that's gross, MAN I LOVE THIS GIRL!" She's my girl and I love her, and even though she's mine, I'll spend the rest of my life doing my best to win her heart each day. She's worth every effort, and more."



What do you think is the biggest misconception about being a pastor's wife?

The biggest misconception for me is that I know everything that is going on at the church with what Roy is doing ministry. Roy doesn't always share a lot with me about his work day. Partly because it doesn't involve me, partly because I don't ask, and partly because many times it seems like we are going 100 mph in 100 directions and we don't always have time to talk. When we do have a chance to talk, most of that time is devoted to discussing our 4 kids (Quinten -15, Trinity -13, Norah -6 and Phoebe -3), whom we love very much, by the way!

What is the greatest blessing of being a pastor's wife?

The greatest blessing of being a pastor's wife has to be the unlimited opportunities to serve others. Roy and I agree that all people are opportunities for the gospel and God's glory. It's great to be a part of and have a front row seat to what our God is doing.

How can the congregation best support you practically and in prayer?

We always appreciate prayers for our family - that we stay the course and serve well. Pray that I be a woman of humility and remain accountable to God's Word. As far as practically, just be you. We love our church family.

Besides being Roy's wife, what are other ways you serve at GBF?

I serve as a small group leader in student ministry for high school girls. I also serve in the nursery rotation. Roy says I am his "partner in ministry" - while I'm not included in a lot of what Roy does, he calls me in to assist him with counseling, planning his calendar, and I nearly always serve as a sounding board for his sermons during the week as he prepares them. *Casey is also in her 2nd year of BTCL (Bible Training Centre for Leaders) at Denton Bible, which meets every Tuesday evening and on some Saturdays.


Movie and/or TV show: Steel Magnolias is my favorite movie, I don't watch much TV, but I enjoy Food Network and Full House

Women's Bible Study


An in-depth Bible study of 1 and 2 Thessalonians by Beth Moore


